Description:	This unit aims to provide a general understanding of the contents of the second section of the Old Testament (from the 8th century prophets) - its background, history, literary forms and theology, as a preparation for ministry.
Method:	Classroom instruction, reading and assignments.
Assessment:	302: One 1500 word essay (40%) and one 2 hour exam (60%). 502: One 10 minute (500 word) seminar presentation (10%), one 1500 word essay (30%), and one 2 hour exam (60%).
